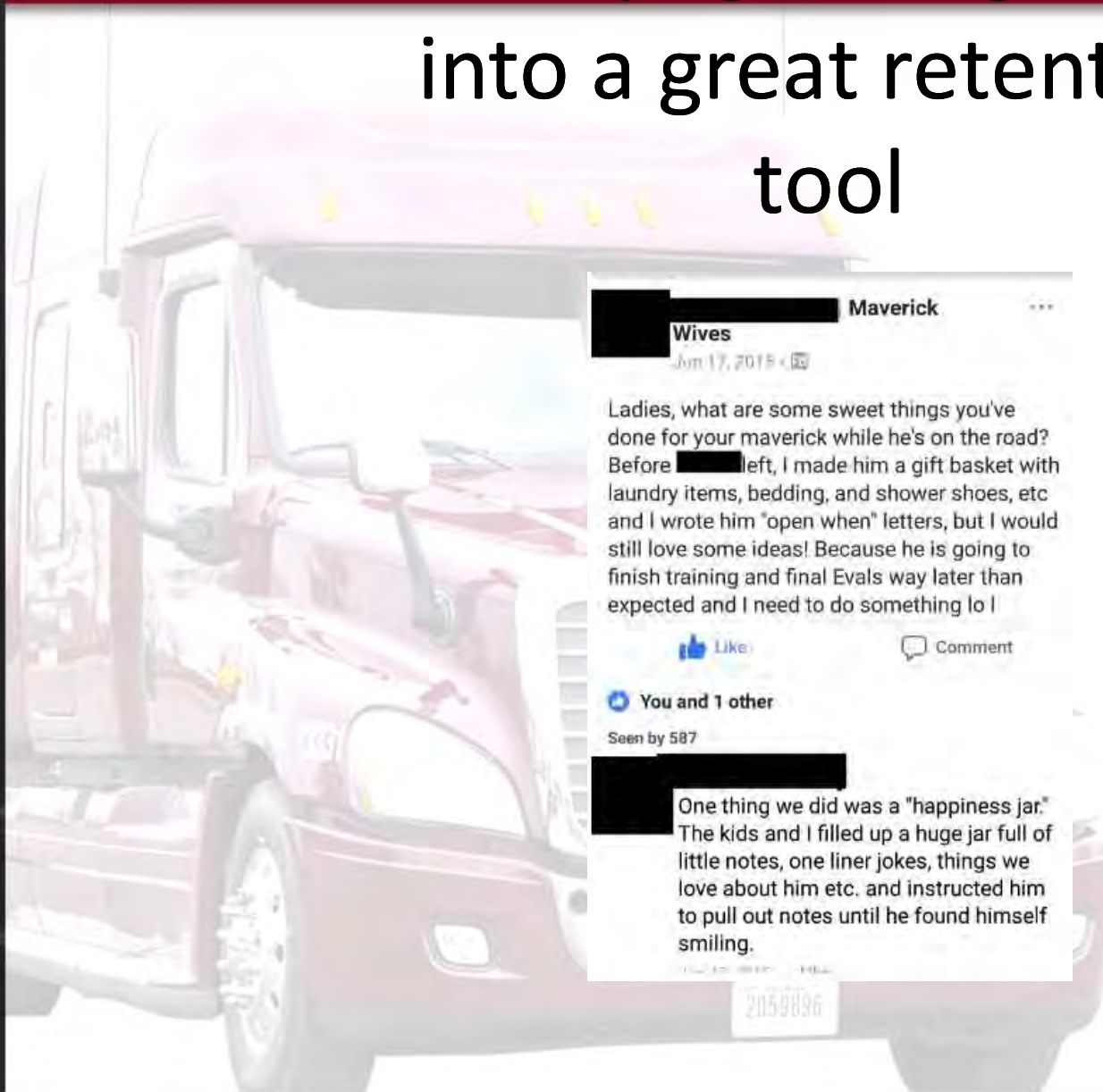

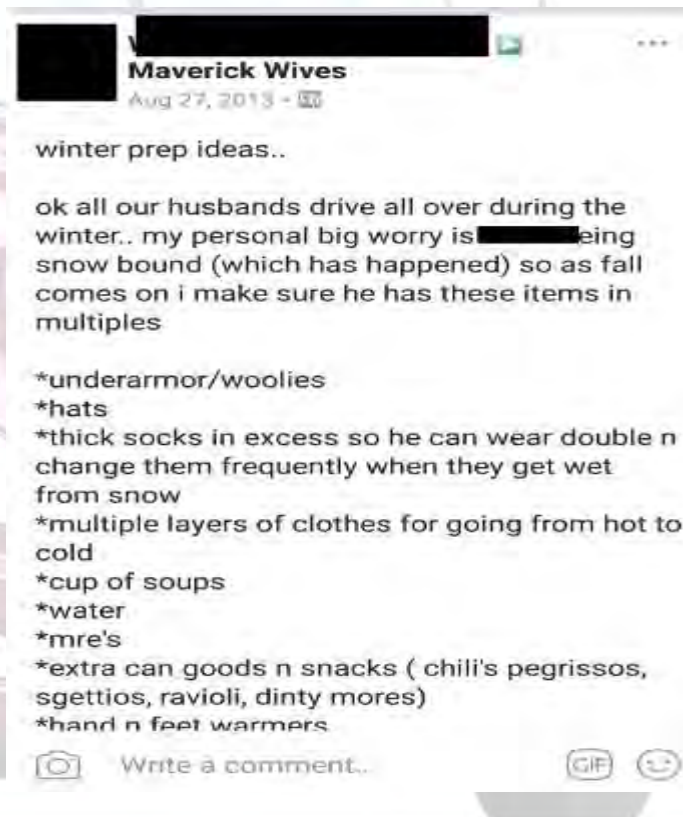
We worked with some of our driver's spouses to start a Wives page in 2013
